


The different layers of his life: Citizen

German 1887-1939 (since 1933 in Exile)

1st Architectural Office in Berlin, Weimar Republic

European

Academie Européenne Méditérrannée, France, 1931-34

British 1939-1946 (since 1933/34 in London/Jerusalem)2nd Office in London Commuting to 3rd Office in Jerusalem

American 1946-1953 (since 1941 in the USA) 4th Office in San Francisco

The different layers of his life: Travels

1919-1932 Countless trips to Building Sites in- and outside Germany

Trips for lectures and commissions: The Netherlands 1920 Palestine, 1923 USA 1924 Russia 1925 Spain 1929 England 1930 Corsika und Greece 1931 Norway, Paris and Côte d´Azur 1932

1933 Emigration via Holland to England 1934-1939 Constant Comuting between London and J'lem

1941 Emigration to USA – Long trip avoiding the Atlantic1941 Road trip through the US1945-1953 Countless trips to Building Sites in the US

The different layers of his work: Music

Central Role as source of inspiration

Many sketches inpired by music

Trips especially to music performances

Theory: Harmonic and contrapunctual conduct in Architecture

The different layers of his work: Nature

Natural phenomena like the dunes on the Courland Spit

or

Snail shells transformed into architecture

The different layers of his work: Art

Studies at TH München, when the Blue Rider was very active

Working in Munich as Costume and Stage Designer

After WWI Co-founder of the **Novembergruppe** and **Arbeitsrat für Kunst**

Member of German Werkbund & Akademie der Künste, Berlin (untill '33)

Cooperation with artists at several buildings (interior and outside fittings)

Friendships (z.B. visiting 1st Bauhaus Exhibition, buying Feininger's Gelmeroda V)

The different layers of his architecture

Connection between Art and Architecture

Design process – sketching onto music, natural phenomena

Architectural production – bringing the "first sketch" into built reality

Innovation – form

- material: Steel + reinforced concrete constructions

typology

Adaptation – surrounding

- Climate
- Materials


The different layers of his work: publications

Very active writer, lecturer and photographer since 1914 and untill 1953:

- Published in articles and books
- Manuscripts in the EM Archiv in the Kunstbibliothek SMB and Getty Research institute, L.A.
- Collection of prints and slides in the EM Archive in the Kunstbibliothek SMB and Getty Research Institute, L.A.

Very active epistoler – to his wife Luise, to family, friends and colleages

The different layers of his work: colleages

Very well connected to the international architectural scene of the time:

In Germany: - Member of the BDA – Bund Deutscher Architekten

- Founding Member of the Zehnerring (later the Ring)
- Member of the German Werkbund

In Britain: Member of RIBA

In the USA: Member of American New Society of Architects and Planners
